Reflection by Fr. Tom

Have you ever felt that you deserved better in life? Perhaps with regards to recognition on a job, or in school, or a youth group? At times things just aren't going the way you'd hoped and you may think that if things were just a little different, if you just had better support, or different friends, you would have a better chance at making a name for yourself, or whatever. The scriptures today indicate a different approach. The Pharisees and others of the gospel were not satisfied to accept where they were in life, not even at the dinner table. They wanted more, more honor and more status. Why should they sit further from the host if the ones between them and the host were not as good or worthy as they? These guests knew the reading from Sirach and they probably thought they were truly humble because they believed they weren't reaching beyond their status in life; rather, they were just assuming their rightful position within God's people. Perhaps they thought of themselves in this way: "I'm a Pharisee who has worked hard in life for God and his people. I pay tithes on all I own and I'm honest about paying the temple tax. I'm an example to others of a true Israelite. Taking a position higher up on the table will remind others of their responsibility to fulfill the law of God as I do. I do this not for myself, but for the people." True humility, however, is different. There is a story of Peter Maurin who, along with Dorothy Day, co-founded the Catholic Worker movement. Peter was invited by some wealthy people to give a presentation on the principles of the Catholic Worker. When he came to the front door of the establishment, he was dressed clean but poorly. He was sent to the back door to take his place with the poor seeking assistance. Without a murmur, he went. Later, when the hosts were wondering where he was, someone accidently found him in the back in conversation with the poor. Peter knew humility. "Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God" (Sirach 3:17).
