Reflection by Javier, CMF

I have always been fond of this story of Zacchaeus, and I suppose it's because, as the third and middle child in my family, I readily related to being "short in stature." I loved to climb trees as a way to hide from others and see beyond my reach. Thus, it is indeed a familiar and beloved story to me. Most commentators reflect on Zacchaeus' status: a despised collector of taxes, who has added on his own commission to become rich. Furthermore, as a dealer in Roman coin, he is unclean according to Jewish law. There is a message in this: that Jesus seeks out those who are marginalized for any reason.

However, a more compelling theme here is the very DESIRE of Zacchaeus to see Jesus, and for us to witness Jesus' response to that desire. Zacchaeus had worldly wealth, but it was simply his heart's desire to see Jesus that sent him "out on a limb" to be able to see. And, Jesus SEES Zacchaeus, up in a tree, and seems to recognize his desire. As we hear in the story, Jesus invites himself to stay at Zacchaeus' house, literally "to abide" with him.

It is evident that Zacchaeus has been changed, that his own desires are fulfilled in Jesus as he gives up the "benefits" of his previous life as a tax collector. He chooses to do justice -- to be in right relationship with others and with God. Jesus even calls Zacchaeus a true descendant of Abraham, a true man of God.

As you go about today think about this questions: What is the deepest desire of your heart? What do you seek to see? Do you seek to see Jesus? Are your desires being fulfilled in faith, in action? Are you willing to welcome Jesus into your home and your heart?


