Reflection by Fr. Tom:

Before the murder of the four North American women by soldiers in El Salvador on 2 December 1980, Sister Ita Ford, a Maryknoll Missionary, had sent a letter to her niece wishing her a happy 16th birthday. She wrote, "I hope you come to find that which gives life a deep meaning for you...something worth living for, maybe even worth dying for...something that energizes you, enthuses you, enables you to keep moving ahead." The four women's faith and ministry to the poor condemned them to death. The youngest, Jean Donovan, was 27. In August of 1936, 51 Claretians, a few priests and the rest seminarians, were executed during the Spanish Civil War. One seminarian, Salvador Pígem, left behind notes that read: "They are killing us out of hatred for religion. Father, forgive them! In our house, we offered no resistance. In jail, our conduct was above reproach. Long live the Immaculate Heart of Mary! They are going to shoot us only for being religious. Don't cry for me. I am a martyr of Jesus Christ....Mama, don't cry. Jesus is asking for my blood; I am going to shed it out of love for Him. I will be a martyr; I'm going to heaven. I will be waiting for you there (12 August 1936)." The youngest martyr was 20. And in April of 1999, during the massacre at Columbine High School, some students, while praying, were asked if they believed in God; scared of being killed, they responded "yes." Today's reading from Maccabees tells of the faith of seven young brothers as they faced their deaths. Looking death in the eyes, feeling the cold barrel of the gun or slick blade of the knife, there is nothing that can prepare you for that moment except faith. Your career, your savings, your health, nothing will help you. Like the disciples at the foot of the cross, they'll all abandon you. Only faith. Jesus spoke of God as "the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob,...not [a] God of the dead, but of the living." Pray for this faith.
