All Saints & All Souls by Jonathan Fox

The harvest is in, the summer is done, the world brown and drab, becomes mindful of death. Snow had not yet descended to comfort and hide the bony trees and blackened fields; so with little effort man can look about and see a meditation on death and life hereafter.

Every year the Church takes this time of year for one of its oldest traditions; to commemorate those who have died. CCM plans to take up this tradition by celebrating Mass in St. Mary's Cemetery on Nov 2nd at 5pm.

All Saints Day, Nov 1st, is a celebration for those souls in heaven, the saints. The Vigil Feast of this Holy Day is popularly known as All Hallow's Eve or Halloween for short. One of the ways this feast was celebrated was to dress up as patron saints, asking for their intercession and sharing the inspiring story of their life.

All Souls Day, Nov 2nd, is a commemoration of those souls not yet in heaven but in purgatory, awaiting the full glory of God in heaven to come once they are purged, or purified clean of all their sins and attachments from earth.

Some of the earliest Masses were celebrated in catacombs right on top of the tombs of famous saints.

By commemorating those who have died, we pray for the souls in purgatory. Our prayers help these souls to receive the grace of God needed to then enter into the heavenly hosts.

The primary Scriptural reference to purgatory is in 2 Maccabees, 12:26 and 12:32.

"Turning to supplication, they prayed that the sinful deed might be fully blotted out... Thus made atonement for the dead that they might be free from sin." Additional references are found in Zechariah, Sirach, and the Gospel of Matthew.

May we all take these liturgical celebrations as an opportunity to remember those we've lost and honor them with our prayers and spiritual offerings.

My hope is that all students have a continuous opportunity to know, love, and serve the Lord; that we all might grow in holiness, pilgrims as we are, on our journey to eternity.

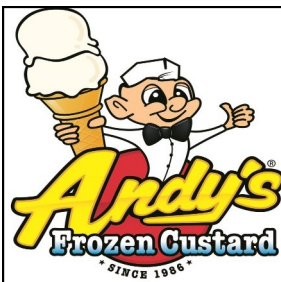
