

Faith in Action by David Herr



Fr. Pedro Arrupe said that the goal of a Catholic education is “To make men and women for and with others... Men and women who cannot even conceive of a love of God, which does not include a love for the least of their neighbors; Men and women completely convinced that love of God which does not issue in justice for others is a farce.” Stirring words. I’ll get back to that later.

When spending time at CCM, I am often reminded of a phrase used in Ignatian spirituality. “Cura Personalis” is a Latin phrase meaning “care for the whole person.” This means paying attention to your unique talents and desires when discerning how to serve God. I think of this phrase because I see a wide variety of talents. I have met many studying to be in the helping profession—nurses, physical therapists, speech therapists, counselors, gerontologists—whose individualized care will help them see the face of Christ in others and be the face of Christ to others. I have met persons studying business and communication, who can effectively reach and positively impact great numbers of people. I have met those learning to be educators who with empower generations. That is only to mention the some of the things people are studying. There are many other aspirations and I am excited at what God is doing.

So many talents and desires to go to great use. One of my greatest regrets from my time as an undergraduate student was that I didn’t get more involved in service. “Now is the time I’m busy studying, and later when I have the skills I’ll serve,” I thought. There were many charity and service opportunities both on and off campus, dangling right in front of me, but I only took up a few.

Don’t do that. Being involved at CCM is a part of your “Catholic education,” that is, your faith formation, your spiritual development, and discernment of your vocation. It is only by stretching yourself and saying “yes” to opportunities to serve that you can experience faith in action and have the chance to prayerfully reflect on your experiences and see what sits well with you or not. This process helps you find discern your vocation. I believe all vocations are about being a “Man or Woman for Others.”






